

Changes suggested by El Salvador to the version of the 23 of January of 2008 taking into account the received communications from Governments

1. To take option 2 from group-decision A.
2. To take option 1 from group-decision B.
3. To delete the paragraph that speaks of the Commission of Innovation and Technology for the Development: Group-Decision "C".
4. In the paragraph "To invite the parliaments...", to replace the current writing: Invite the parliaments to create regional networks for the exchange of experiences with the use of ICTs in parliaments, with a view to strengthening democracy;

By the following one:

Invite the parliaments to create regional networks for the exchange of experiences with the use of ICTs in themselves;

5. In the paragraph "Invite the judiciary..." put the note "(provisionally agreed)"
6. In measure 6 (5):

Substitute the current text:

Ensure that 80% of national educational portals fulfill the eligibility requirements for becoming full members of the regional networks (RELPE) of such portals. (RELPE exclusively or there are any others)

By:

Ensure that 80% of national educational portals fulfill the eligibility requirements for becoming full members of the regional networks of such portals.

7. In measures 12(10) y 13(11);
Given that they were discussed and agreed, put the note "(provisionally agreed)".
8. In measure 18(13.2):
Substitute the current text:

Optimize existing infrastructure of telecommunication networks, and extend the fiber optic networks to ensure more bandwidth.

By:

To promote the improvement of existing telecommunications networks infrastructure, including the extension of fiber optic networks to increase the coverage of broadband services.

9. In measure 43(32):
Put the note “(provisionally agreed)”.
10. In measure 70(51), add an additional option:
Discuss intellectual property issues related with ICT and digital services, including content protection the different license models for the protection of copyright, taking into account the relevant work done by WIPO and other fora, particularly the results of the Development Agenda, and the national legislation and international agreements, with the aim to strengthen the relationship between intellectual property and a development-oriented Information Society.
11. In measure 70(51), add an additional option:
Discuss intellectual property issues related with ICT and digital services, including content protection, taking into account the legislation and agreements that are in force.
12. In measures 83(62), 84(62.1), 85(62.2) put the note “(provisionally agreed)”.
13. Make an amendment to paragraph 86(62.3), adding the word “technical”:
Set up a working group involving ITU and relevant national and regional technical actors to discuss and inform the Follow-up Mechanism on activities geared towards the appropriate use of the radioelectric spectrum in the public interest and diversity, in accordance with the principle of legality and in full compliance with the relevant international laws and agreements, as well as national and international regulations.
14. Add the following alternative to paragraph 87(62.31):
Promote a regional agreement that allows the implementation of digital systems for audio broadcasting services, in which the use of allocated radioelectric spectrum is to be used efficiently, with simultaneous transmissions, digital and analogical, therefore making a gradual transition in accordance with each country reality, ensuring the continuity of an open broadcasting, of free emission and reception.
15. In measures 88(62.4), 89(62.5), 90(62.6), 91(63), 92 (63.1), 93(64), 94(65), 95(66), put the note “(provisionally agreed)”.
16. In annex 1, substitute the current drafting of paragraph 4.4:

4.4 We decide that the regional focal point should work in conjunction with ECLAC to create synergies with the initiatives of international or regional agencies that may be able to contribute to the achievement of the goals set out in eLAC 2010 and, where appropriate make suggestions for action to Member States.

By the following:

4.4 We decide that ECLAC gives technical support to the regional focal point with the aim to create synergies with initiatives of international or regional agencies that may be able to contribute to the achievement of the goals set out in eLAC 2010 and, when appropriate, that the regional focal point make suggestions to Member States.

- 17.** Add the following alternative to paragraph 4.4 in annex 1:
4.4 The eLAC programme should benefit, where appropriate, from initiatives of international or regional agencies that may be able to contribute to the achievement of the goals set out in eLAC 2010.
- 18.** Check the Grammar and style changes suggested by Barbados to the English version.
- 19.** Delete the phrases relative to Delphi priorities. They only will be kept in the referenced plan.
